The Velo Theatre was founded by Tania Castaing & Charlot Lemoine issue of the Beaux Arts in London and Angers. Since 1981 they have been working towards an intimate and poetic relationship with the public. Believing that emotions are born from the fragile relationship that the actor establishes with the objects surrounding him; Velo Theatre amongst others, invented a new style of expression, Object Theatre. Although they have since added text to certain creations, the joy of manipulating objects is still intense and intact. In 1993 the company moved to a disused fruit preserving factory in Apt, Vaucluse. Now transformed into a theatre, it has become their home base, as well as a reception space for other national and international theatre groups in residence. Velo Theatre poetic migrants and pilgrims, have toured the world since 30 years, with silent or polyglot shows addressing one and all.



In full delivery uniform, a postman carries on his bicycle the teater for his dreams, in booby-trapped parcels, crammed with explosive images. In breaking into the secrets of his parcels, he will reveal a fabulous continent, an illusion of holidays, a climate of uninhabited games against background of palm trees and ocean.

HOUSE

- 150 seat maximum, raked auditorium with full blackout capability

STAGE SPACE

- Width of performance area: 6 meters (19,5 feet)
- Wing space: 4 meters (13 feet) minimum stage left, 1 meter (3 feet) stage right
- Depth of performance area: 5 meters (16 feet) curtain to back wall
- Depth of stage: 6 meters (19,5 feet) apron to back wall
- Height: 4 meters (13 feet)
- Matte black floor with no rake

SOFT GOODS

- Black back drop with no fullness and four black legs

LIGHTING

- 9 x 1 000 watts profiles spots (1 with iris)
- 12 x 1 000 watts spots with barn doors
- 1 dimmer board non computerised, with at least 20 circuits for 2 000 watts
- 2 blue, 1 orange gels

SOUND

- 2 speakers on stage at back wall
- 1 amplifier
- Mini-disc, supplied by the company

CREW

- Load-in and set-up will need between 4 and 6 hours
- Strike and load-out will need 1 hour 1/2


